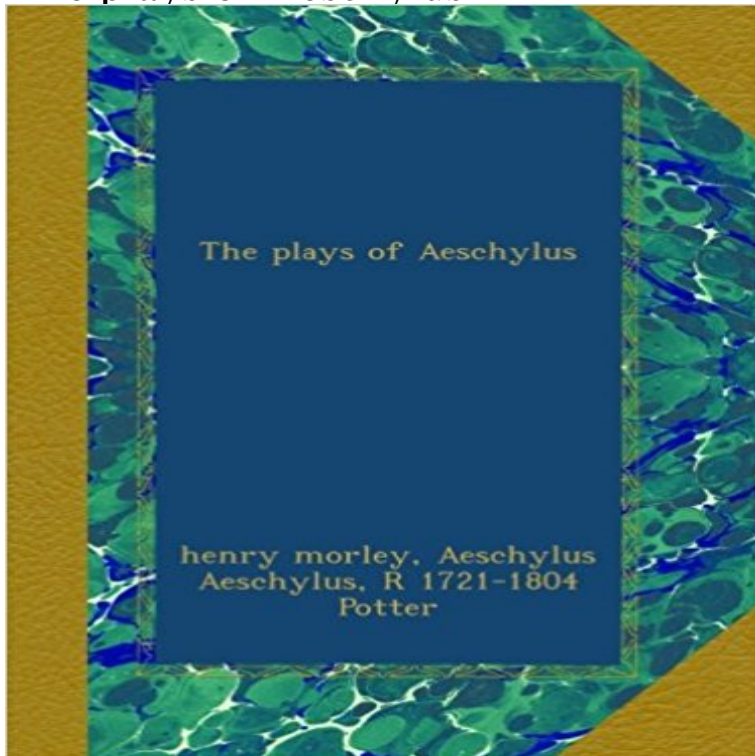


The plays of Aeschylus
